**Amends Constitution: Creates right to carry a concealed firearm without a permit;  
voids existing concealed carry restrictions**

**Result of “Yes” Vote:** “Yes” vote amends constitution. Creates right to carry concealed firearm without permit; voids laws generally prohibiting carrying concealed firearms but allowing concealed handguns with permit.

**Result of “No” Vote:** “No” vote retains current laws that generally prohibit carrying concealed firearms (with exceptions for law enforcement, others) but allow carrying concealed handguns with permit.

**Summary:** Amends Constitution. The Oregon Constitution currently provides right to bear “arms,” including some firearms. The state may regulate firearm ownership and use to protect public safety. State laws currently allow carrying a concealed handgun with a permit issued by local sheriff. Sheriff shall issue permit to lawful residents who are at least 21 years of age, have no outstanding warrants, are not on pretrial release, and demonstrate competence with a handgun as specified by statute; ineligible persons include felons, recent misdemeanants, sex offenders, and those dishonorably discharged from U.S. armed forces, among others. Laws otherwise prohibit carrying concealed firearms, with exceptions for law enforcement, active-duty military, specified target shooting, and others. Measure voids those laws; creates right to carry concealed firearm without a permit.

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**Instructions for Circulators**

- 1 Only active Oregon voters may sign a petition. Ask each signer if they are an active registered voter in Oregon.
- 2 A single circulator must personally witness all signatures collected on any one signature sheet. After witnessing each signature on a sheet, use a pen to sign and date the circulator certification.
- 3 Initial any changes you make to the date you signed the certification. A complete list of allowable circulator certification corrections is provided in the Circulator Training Manual available at [www.oregonvotes.gov](http://www.oregonvotes.gov).
- 4 **It is against the law for circulators to:**
  - Circulate a petition containing a false signature.
  - Make false statements to any person who signs the petition or requests information about it.
  - Attempt to obtain the signature of a person who is not qualified to sign the petition.
  - Offer money or anything of value to another person to sign or not sign the petition.
  - Sell or offer to sell signature sheets.
  - Write, alter, correct, clarify or obscure any information about the signers unless the signer is disabled and requests assistance or the signer initials after the changes are made.
  - Accept compensation to circulate a petition that is based on the number of signatures obtained.

**⚠ Warning** Violations of the circulator requirements may result in conviction of a felony with a fine of up to \$125,000 and/or prison for up to 5 years.

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**Instructions for Signers**

- 1 Only active Oregon voters may sign a petition. Use a pen to sign your name, as you did when you registered to vote.
- 2 Provide the date you signed the petition, your printed name and residence address. Only you may complete this optional information.
- 3 Initial any changes the circulator makes to your printed name, residence address or date you signed the petition.
- 4 **It is against the law for signers to:**
  - Sign another person’s name under any circumstances.
  - Sign a petition more than one time.
  - Sign a petition when you are not qualified to sign it.
