## Amends Constitution: P rent may select any public school statewide; district must admit, space permitting. Limited admission priorities

Result of "Yes" Vote: Parent may select any public/charter school statewide; district must admit student, space permitting. Priority for residents, returning students; no other preferences allowed. Admissions lottery.

**Result of "No" Vote:** "No" vote retains current law. No constitutional right to select among public schools. Schools may prioritize admission for sibling preference, academics, at-risk status, other criteria.

**Summary:** Amends constitution. Currently, parents may transfer children between K-12 public schools, when permitted by district. Schools may prioritize admission for sibling preference, academics, at-risk status, other criteria. Measure gives parents right to select any public/charter school statewide. District must admit student, space permitting. Priority given first to resident of attendance zone (assigned area where resident child attends specific school); second to district resident; third to outside district. No other preference allowed. When space limited, school uses lottery for each priority level. Returning students need not reapply. Admission open throughout school year. District not required to transport child outside assigned attendance zone. Districts lose functing for each departing student, gain funding for each incoming student. State adopts uniform application for enrollment. Applies starting July 2025.

## Instructions for Circulators

- 1 Only active Oregon voters may sign a petition. Ask each signer if they are an active registered voter in Oregon.
- 2 A single circulator must personally witness all signatures collected on any one signature sheet. After witnessing each signature on a sheet, use a pen to sign and date the circulator certification.
- 3 Initial any changes you make to the date you signed the certification. A complete list of allowable circulator certification corrections is provided in the Circulator Training Manual aVailable at www.oregonvotes.gov.
- 4 it is against the law for circulators to:
  - $\rightarrow$  Circulate a petition containing a false signature.
  - → Make false statements to any person who signs the petition or requests information about it.
  - → Attempt to obtain the signature of a person who is not qualified to sign the petition.
  - → Offer money or anything of value to another person to sign or not sign the petition.
  - → Sell or offer to sell signature sheets.
  - → Write, alter, correct, clarify or obscure any information about the signers unless the signer is disabled and requests assistance or the signer initials after the changes are made.
  - → Accept compensation to circulate a petition that is based on the number of signatures obtained.
- **Warning** Violations of the circulator requirements may result in conviction of a felony with a fine of up to \$125,000 and/or prison for up to 5 years.

## Instructions for Signers

- 1 Only active Oregon voters may sign a petition. Use a pen to sign your name, as you did when you registered to vote.
- 2 Provide the date you signed the petition, your printed name and residence address. Only you may complete this optional information.
- 3 Initial any changes the circulator makes to your printed name, residence address or date you signed the petition.
- 4 it is against the law for signers to:
  - → Sign another person's name under any circumstances.
  - → Sign a petition more than one time.
  - → Sign a petition when you are not qualified to sign it.
